The binder will be updated by the Secretary of the Board and when a new officer is elected the binder will be passed over to them by the outgoing officer.

## IG Bylaws:

It was determined that **Article X**, **Section 3**, **Item B**, pertaining to abstinence requirements for Region Representative needs to be changed from 6 months of abstinence to 1 year of abstinence. This will put us in agreement with Region 5 requirements.

It was decided among the board members that they would bring to the full IG board a request to update **Article XII**, **Section 9**, **Item G**: "Establish and maintain an office, based on the will of the IG Representatives," that this Item be deleted from the Bylaws.

### **IG Policy and Procedure Manual:**

Several updates, corrections, and clarifications were made to the policy manual too numerous to mention here. The document, with changes noted, will be submitted to the full board for their review and comments ahead of the November meeting.
