Welcome: Chris A. from the Wednesday Early Bird meeting and Mary C from the Columbia MO meeting announced that they were our new IG reps from those respective meetings. Our IG Secretary confirmed email addresses.

Minutes: The minutes from November 10, 2024 IG meetings were approved as submitted.

Reports: There were no questions or comments about the reports submitted prior to the meeting.

Seventh Tradition Collection – Our treasurer reminded IG members of our 7th tradition and the importance of giving what you can when you can.

New Business:

The **2025 Intergroup Budget** was presented by our outgoing Treasurer, Marina F. The board of trustees met in December to create this budget. As always, and per state law, a balanced budget was presented.

Elections: the following positions and candidates were presented for election:

Board of Trustees – Vice-Chair Amy G. Fall 2025 Retreat Co-Chairperson – Amy G. Fall 2025 Retreat Co-Chairperson – Cindy H. Newsletter Chairperson – J-MO Twelfth Step Within Chairperson – Bonnie G.

All candidates were approved as presented, with thanks for their service.

7th Tradition funds distribution – Julie J, Treasurer. WSO is requesting that groups and individuals split their contributions as follows:

50 % to Intergroup – 10% less than the prior recommendation 40% to World Service Office – 10% more than the prior recommendation 10% to Region 5 – no change

The board of Trustees supports the recommendation WSO has made, while honoring the autonomy of groups and will monitor, with particular attention mid-year, to see how this is impacting Intergroup and reporting out at that time.

There was good discussion about this recommendation and a few clarifications were also made. The question was asked, "If my home group does not have a treasurer does that mean that I should be making three donations...one to IG, one to Region 5, and one to WSO?" Yes, that is the procedure. If a member's home group does have a treasurer, they can simply make one donation to that home group, then the treasurer of the group will distribute in the three ways listed above.

We also were given clarification on our donations to IG meetings. In the past, when we were flush with cash, we gave a very generous donation to WSO, typically exceeding the suggested guidelines. However, given our current more austere budget, it is our intention to follow the guidelines suggested, at least for the foreseeable future.

Region 5 Update – Amy G., Vice-Chair & Region 5 Rep reminded everyone that the Region 5 Convention will be held May 23-25 in Brookfield, WI.






